About the Event

Westside Regional Center is organizing a series of training events on evidence-based practices approved by the Los Angeles County Department of Mental Health (LAC DMH) for Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) services. Standard Stepping Stones Triple P has been developed for parents of children (up to 12 years of age) with a developmental disability. It provides parents with comprehensive support in managing their child's behavior across settings (e.g., disobedience, fighting and aggression, and temper tantrums). This training course will help practitioners provide parents with a variety of parenting skills that will promote their child's development and potential.

Note: The LAC DMH has not approved Triple P Stepping Stones as an MHSA PEI practice. Therefore, providers are not allowed to claim PEI for any services using Triple P Stepping Stones. The only approved PEI Triple P Modalities/Levels are Level 4 Standard and Teen as well as Level 5 Pathways and Enhanced.

The Standard Stepping Stones Triple P training series includes: 3 initial training days (November 16-18, 2015), a pre-accreditation workshop (December 16, 2015), and an accreditation workshop (January 13 OR 14, 2016).

Participants will be able to:

1. Detect and effectively manage child behavior problems
2. Recognize risk and protective factors operating within families
3. Describe core principles of positive parenting and behavior change
4. Perform advanced assessment of child and family functioning
5. Apply key parenting strategies to a broad range of target behaviors
6. Identify strategies for promoting generalization and maintenance of behavior change
7. Recognize indicators that suggest the presence of additional family risk factors
